



Andersonstown Powwow Selects Norris Chee as Featured Artist

(Anderson, IN) The Andersonstown Powwow has selected Native American artist Norris Chee as the featured artist for the 2005 Andersonstown Powwow to be held the weekend of September 10 and 11 at Athletic Park in Anderson.

A nationally accomplished artist, Chee's work has been recognized at the Santa Fe Indian Market, Eiteljorg Indian Market in Indianapolis and the American Indian Arts Festival and Market, Dallas TX. Born on the reservation in Mexican Hat, Utah, Chee currently resides in Lexington, Nebraska where he operates Blue Horse Studio. A member of the Edgewater Clan related to the Manygoats Clan of the Dineh Tribe, Chee also works as an Artist in Residence for the state of Nebraska. Visiting schools and communities, he teaches them about his artistic talents, methods and about the customs of his tribe.

Last year, more than 4,000 eventgoers attended the first Andersonstown Powwow and Indian Market and more than 100 dancers from Oklahoma and throughout the Midwest participated in inter-tribal celebration.

Onsite Camping is also available this year for vendors, artists and dancers. Electrical sites are limited; early application is encouraged.
